

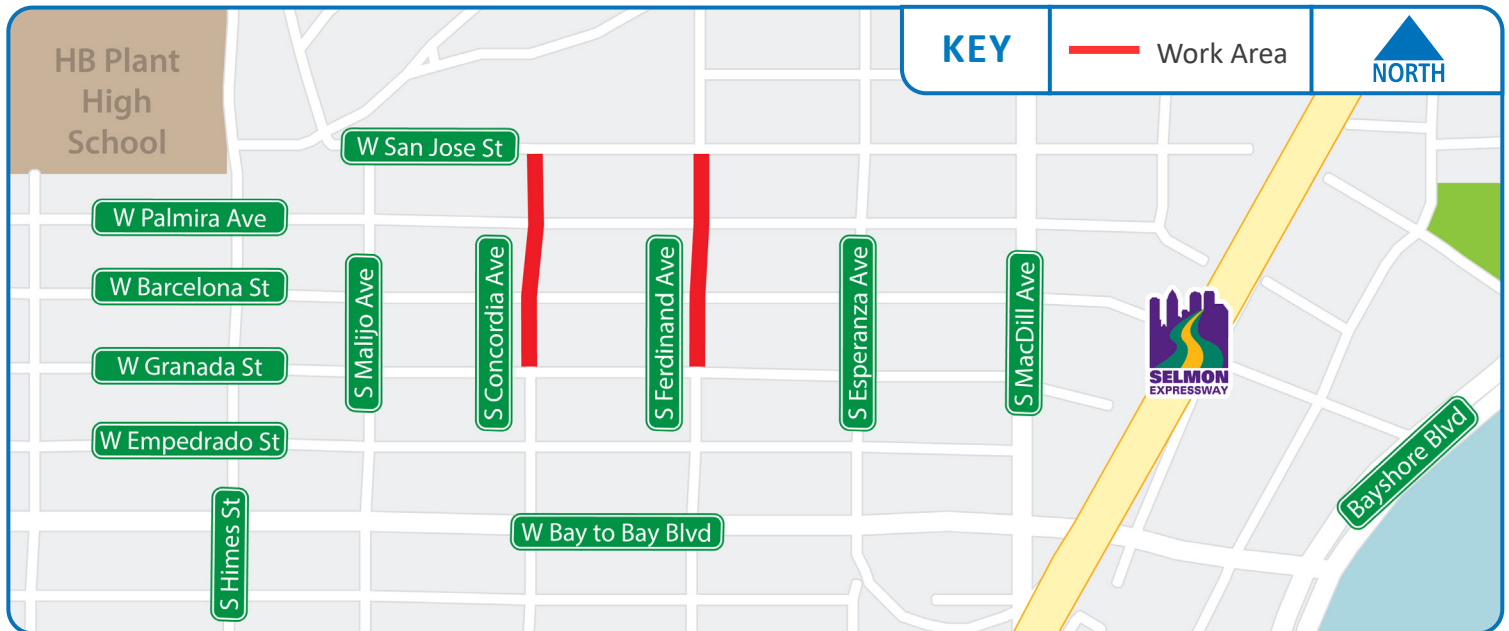


PALMA CEIA WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS

June 2023

NOTICE OF UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

As part of the City of Tampa's Palma Ceia Water Main Improvements Project Phase III, **directional drilling and boring will occur on South Concordia Avenue between West Granada Street and West San Jose Street beginning Monday, June 19, 2023**, and continuing for one week, weather permitting. **These construction activities will occur on South Ferdinand Avenue between West Granada Street and West San Jose Street beginning Monday, June 26, 2023**, and continuing for one week, weather permitting. Large excavation and drilling equipment will be moving through the area while work is under way so residents are advised not to park vehicles on the street. No interruptions to water service, mail or trash pick-up are anticipated. [See map below for location of construction activities.](#)



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Activities to occur within the public right-of-way
- Staging of equipment and materials in the public right-of-way
- Flagging operations as needed
- Removal of landscape and hardscape from the public right-of-way
- Vehicles parked on the street may be required to park elsewhere during construction
- Property owners located along the route may experience brief water service interruption as existing meters are transferred to the new water main
- Access to homes will be maintained
- No anticipated interruptions to trash collection/recycling or mail delivery
- Hours of operation are 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.
